Danger For Environment.

Odour	Unpleasant odour, Strong smell of phenol.
Appearance	Liquid, brown, dispersible in water.
Contact with eyes	Can cause damage to the eyes.
Contact with skin	Causes burns (R34), Toxic in contact with skin and if swallowed (R24/25).

4. FIRST AID MEASURES
